Tree height (excluding pot): 420 mm

Branch spread: approx. 480 mm

Pot: Signed Tokoname oval pot, antique and beautifully patinated, YAMAACKI, 360 x 290 x 55 mm

Style: Moyogi (informal upright) Trunk diameter: 60 mm Nebari: 170 mm
Characteristics: Well-formed branch pads, no major wire marks or heavy pruning scars. Older wounds were carefully refined to promote optimal healing and protected with cut paste.

Good alternated branch distribution. Spring foliage is soft green with slightly crisp leaves, turning fiery red-orange in autumn. Cultivation / Exposure: Sunny exposure recommended to achieve strong autumn coloration.

A fine specimen, reworked to refine its ramification, obtained by air layering, therefore with no grafting marks. Intended for collectors. Origin: From the highly reputed Imai Chiaru nurseries in Japan, renowned for the quality of their master pieces. Photographed in January 2026. Sold without display stand.
